They describe themselves as "a movement for tens of millions of Americans who are fed up with the dysfunction and sill no longer put up with a government that does not represent the interests of most Americans." They promote bipartisan engagement at the Federal level. As super PAC, they can raise and spend unlimited amounts of money, but cannot contribute directly to a politician or political party.
