<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Citizens for Fair Tax Policy</u></b></p> <p>Citizens for Fair Tax Policy is an Arizona PAC that has been funded entirely by the <b>National Association of Realtors and their PAC</b>. <i>This is dark money!</i> The National Association of Realtors is a trade association (501c6), and therefore <b>does not have to reveal its contributors</b>. Their goal is "working to protect and promote homeownership and property investment. The REALTOR® Party speaks with one voice to advance candidates that build strong communities and promote a vibrant business environment." The sole contributor is their national organization which is a 501c4, <i>a dark money organization</i>. However, they do NOT oppose having to report their contributors. They advocate for changes in public education "to ensure that all children, regardless of their background, graduate from high school prepared for, and with access to, a college. Their interest in Prop 126 is based on a recent report from the Grand Canyon Institute (<a href="http://grandcanyoninstitute.org/">http://grandcanyoninstitute.org/</a>) which bills itself as "Arizona's Centrist Think Tank.
