Clean Energy for Healthy Arizona is a PAC. Its sole contributor is **NextGen Climate Action**, a 501c4 organization that advocates on environmental issues. As a 501c4, it does not have to report its contributors, but **Tom Steyer** publicly claims that he is the source of NextGen funding. Tom Steyer is an American billionaire hedge fund manager philanthropist, environmentalist, liberal activist and fundraiser.

**Arizonans for Affordable Electricity**

Arizonans for Affordable Electricity is a PAC that is entirely funded by the **Pinnacle West Capital Corporation**. PWCC derives essentially all revenues and earnings their wholly-owned subsidiary, **Arizona Public Service** ("APS"). APS is an electric utility that provides most of the State of Arizona, 1.2 million customers in total. APS is also the operator and co-owner of the Palo Verde Generating Station – a primary source of electricity for the Southwest. *This means these ads are ultimately being funded by people who pay electric bills in Arizona.*

**Save Native American Families**

Save Native American Families is an Arizona PAC that is required to report its contributors. It is entirely funded by one donor – **the Navajo Transitional Energy Company**, an LLC owned by the Navajo Nation. They mine coal to produce energy.

**Southern Arizonans for Responsible Energy**

Southern Arizonans for Responsible Energy is an Arizona PAC that is required to report its contributors. There is one contributor to this PAC - **Unisource Energy Corporation**, a for profit Arizona corporation that is the parent company of **Tucson Electric Power (TEP)**. **Ultimately, the TEP ratepayers are footing the bill.**
