This ad and the #YesForEd branding is a clear rip-off from the teachers who oppose Prop 305 – a shameless intent to mislead the voters. This ad was the first to earn ODM’s first Hall of Shame designation.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>UFCW Local 99</u></p> <p>United Food and Commercial Workers Local 99 is the Arizona affiliate of this national union. This is an Arizona “MegaPAC” which means that it receives at least ten dollars in contributions from at least five hundred individuals in the four-year period immediately before application to the secretary of state. UFCW has more than 23,000 members including grocery workers, legal aid workers, custodial workers, parking lot attendants, food processors, farm growers and medical office workers.
