**Initiative Description:**  
The Stop Political Dirty Money Constitutional Amendment establishes your Right to Know the identity of all major contributors who are trying to influence the outcome of Arizona elections. Contributors will no longer be able to hide by transferring their money through intermediaries. Anyone spending more than \$10,000 to oppose or support candidates or ballot measures must disclose everyone who contributed \$2,500 or more personally, publicly and under penalty of perjury. The money must be tracked back to its original source. Violators will be subject to fines. Rules to implement this Amendment will be written by the Secretary of State.

**Notice:** This is only a description of the measure. It may not include every provision contained in the measure. Before signing, make sure the title and text of the measure are attached. You have the right to read or examine the measure and text before signing.

**Initiative Measure to be Submitted Directly to Electors**  
The following proposed amendment to the constitution shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the state of Arizona for their approval or rejection at the next regular general election and each subsequent general election.

We, the undersigned, do hereby petition the Secretary of State to submit the following proposed amendment to the constitution to the qualified electors of the state of Arizona for their approval or rejection at the next regular general election and each subsequent general election.

for himself says: I have personally signed this petition with my own name. I have not signed any other petition for the same measure. I am a qualified elector of the state of Arizona, county of **PIMA**.

**Warning:** It is a class 1 misdemeanor for any person to knowingly sign an initiative or referendum petition with a name other than his own, except in a circumstance where he signs for a person, in the presence of and at the specific request of such person, who is incapable of signing his own name because of physical infirmity, or to knowingly sign his name more than once for the same measure, or to knowingly sign such petition when he is not a qualified elector.

This highlighted signature was randomly chosen by the Secretary of State for the 5% sample to be verified by the County Recorders. Each good signature in that sample represents 20 signatures. If a signature in the sample is not readable or the signer is not registered to vote, 20 signatures will be deducted from our total!

Sign the petition with the same <b>name that is on the voter registration</b> – if in doubt, ask the signer to use their full legal name (their drivers license is a good indication) Usually, nicknames and initials are not used to register. Remind people to sign between the lines. Skip a line if a signature encroaches into the box below.	Printed names must be readable!			Must be readable! If someone has recently moved and not changed their address on the voter rolls, use the current address and encourage the voter to update their registration.  <b>Street addresses only! NO PO BOXES!!</b>		The City must be in the County for this petition. If the county line goes through a city (i.e. Sedona or Queen Creek) be sure to clarify which county the signer lives in.	Any signature dated after the date the petition was notarized (on the back) will NOT be counted.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Information <b>not legible</b>? Ask the person to cross off the signature line with a straight edge and have them sign again.</li> <li>If the <b>signer tries to scratch something out</b>, have him or her move to the next clean line and start over. Have the person cross out original information with a straight-edge.</li> <li><b>Make sure information is in the right field!</b> Example: people frequently automatically write their City and Zip Code in the same field as their Street Address. No worries! Just make sure the information is ALSO in the City and Zip Code fields.</li> <li><b>No ditto marks in any field!</b></li> </ul>
